Background

Engineering Construction Activity

Engineering Construction Activity is a publication which provide estimates of value of engineering construction work done, commenced and yet to be done.

Reference Period September 2020

Key Statistics during the September quarter:

- Seasonally adjusted work done fell 1.7%.
- Seasonally adjusted work done for the private sector fell 4.2%.
- Value of work commenced increased 13.9% in original terms.

Total: The seasonally adjusted estimate for the value of total engineering construction work done fell 1.7% in the September quarter to \$22,583.9m.

Private sector: The seasonally adjusted estimate for the value of work done for the private sector fell 4.2% in the September quarter to \$13,445.2m.

Public sector: The seasonally adjusted estimate for the value of work done for the public sector rose 2.1% in the September quarter to \$9,138.7m.
